No expectation / hope for themselves –

Reactive not proactive

Social connection – St Lukes have done leaflet drops 2 /3 times offering wider 'services' eg, trip to cinema, Blackpool in October, farm in May, camping etc. but people had said there is nothing going on.

Needs to be on leaflet – and do Galli first.

New theatre group for children – only 8/9

New coffee morning social space – but as yet no uptake.

Facing barriers with volunteers – people have a fixed mindset around services should give and so church starting to push back a little in terms of trying to get people to engage.

Roots led on a community clean up – Jason is keen on social transformation for litter.

Traffic – still a bit of nightmare in terms of rabbit run and parking for school or Tesco.

Needle waste – some found on the community clean up day.

There are crack dens – substance misuse is common in the bushes. Figures off NORIS?

Using the wasteland green space as space to inject.

SPARK – another needle exchange somewhere? Lots of logistical issues around it.
